Position Title: Domestic Violence/Sexual Assault Therapist Intern

Position Type: 40 hours per week

Job Description: Under the direction of the Director of Clinical Programs, the DV/SA Therapist will provide specialized clinical services to adults who are survivors of domestic violence, sexual assault and human trafficking. Services will include but not be limited to, assessment, individual and group therapy, case management, resource and referral, and crisis intervention.

Reports To: Director of Clinical Programs

Pay: \$35,360 (additional \$.50/hr for Spanish-speaker) + benefits

### Job Responsibilities:

- Individual and family therapy utilizing appropriate interventions including, but not limited to: Cognitive-Behavioral Therapy, Dialectical Behavior Therapy, Motivational Interviewing, and Structural Family Therapy
- Facilitate support, educational, and process groups
- Complete necessary trauma-informed training specific to human trafficking, sexual assault, and domestic violence survivors
- Complete client assessments, discharges, progress notes and letters, and client plans in the time prescribed by policy and contract
- Provide case management services and make referrals for community services as needed
- Attend all required meetings and trainings
- Attend clinical supervision on a regular basis as assigned and required
- Assist in community education and public speaking
- Participate in committee work as requested
- Other duties as assigned

### Administrative Duties

- Submit required documentation for grant monitoring.
- Participate in agency staff meeting and required trainings.
- Provide back up to crisis line on an assigned basis.
- Other duties as assigned.

### Qualifications:

- **Bilingual English/Spanish preferred.**
- High degree of sensitivity to and respect for diversity and cultural issues involved in working with individual of varying ethnicities and income
- Must be at least 21 years of age
- Graduation from a master's level counseling program from an accredited school
- Possesses a valid intern number through the California Board of Behavioral Sciences if ASW/MFTI/PCI
- Must have the ability to work under conditions requiring flexibility and team member response to crisis
- Valid California driver's license
- CPR/First Aid certificates strongly encouraged
